General Range Safety Rules:

- 1. Always treat the gun like it is loaded. Never assume it is unloaded. Check it! And then re-check it!
- 2. <u>Always</u> keep your gun pointed in a safe direction. This means in your vehicle, transporting it to the range area from your vehicle and while in the range area, and especially when it is loaded on the range.
- 3. <u>Always</u> keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot. This means your sights are on the target and you have made the decision to fire before your finger touches the trigger.
- 4. <u>Always</u> know your target, what is around and beyond it. You are responsible for every round that comes out of the end of your muzzle on or off the range.
- 5. <u>Always</u> keep the gun unloaded until ready to use. On True North Firearms Center Complex we run a cold range; meaning your gun should only be loaded when you are on the firing line and are ready to shoot. A loaded gun should never leave the firing line.

For the safety of everyone on the complex please follow these five safety rules at all times.
