

General Range Safety Rules:

1. **Always treat the gun like it is loaded.** Never assume it is unloaded. Check it! And then re-check it!
2. **Always keep your gun pointed in a safe direction.** This means in your vehicle, transporting it to the range area from your vehicle and while in the range area, and especially when it is loaded on the range.
3. **Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.** This means your sights are on the target and you have made the decision to fire before your finger touches the trigger.
4. **Always know your target, what is around and beyond it.** You are responsible for every round that comes out of the end of your muzzle on or off the range.
5. **Always keep the gun unloaded until ready to use.** On True North Firearms Center Complex we run a cold range; meaning your gun should only be loaded when you are on the firing line and are ready to shoot. A loaded gun should never leave the firing line.

For the safety of everyone on the complex please follow these five safety rules at all times.
