True North Firearms Center Site Specific Safety Rules Rifle Range

- 1. Always treat the gun like it is loaded.
- 2. Always keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
- 3. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- 4. Always know your target, what is around and beyond it.
- 5. Always keep the gun unloaded until ready to use.
- 6. No one under the age of 18 is allowed on the range without the supervision of a responsible parent or legal guardian.
- 7. No unattended children allowed on the property or range at any time.
- 8. No one is allowed to handle a gun while anyone is down range. (This means when anyone is forward the firing line. It should be on the bench with the muzzle pointed down range, the action facing up and open or cylinder open as well as unloaded and you should not be on or around the firing line.
- 9. Only shooters and <u>one</u> other person working with the shooter allowed at the firing line at a time. All others should be in the spectator area.
- 10. Everyone in the range area must wear eye and ear protection.
- 11. Food and beverages are prohibited on the firing line. They should be kept in the ready area. Smoking is permitted in the smoking area only.
- **12.** You are responsible for containing your rounds within the range area. No shots are to leave the range. If so, report to Management.
- 13. Tracers, armor piercing, incendiary, 50 caliber, handguns, shotguns, explosives or fully automatic fire is prohibited. Any questions see Management.
- **14.** Never leave a gun unattended at any time. Your gun and ammunition are <u>always</u> your responsibility.
- 15. No horseplay when handling a gun or while in the range area.
- 16. Respect the center as well as other members; put your trash in the trash receptacle, pick up your brass and put it in the brass recycle bin. Clean up behind yourself.
- 17. Be respectful and courteous of others time and space while on the range.
